The following information must always be provided for all bank accounts:

1. Country of Bank
2. Bank Name
3. Branch Address
4. Account Holder Name
5. Account Number
6. Swift/BIC code
7. Currency code

Please provide Bank Branch Name where available.

The following tables provide further information on the use of:

- IBAN (International Bank Account Number) which has been adopted in many countries and must be provided for accounts in these countries.
- The use of Local Clearing Codes (SORTABA/IFSC/REG etc) in specific countries
- Countries which have standardized the length of the account number

If the country where your bank account is held is not on any of these three lists, then please provide the above seven pieces of information.

Only the bank servicing an account can provide the correct account code, the related Bank Identifier Code (SWIFT/BIC), Account number, IBAN and Local Clearing Code. Please consult your bank statements or with your bank, if necessary.
