

Indico.UN Project updates:


Achievements of 2022

- Code freeze for version 1 of Indico.UN in place
- Analytical module deployed for all users along with a web service for clients
- Disaster recovery exercise successfully conducted
- New and transparent cost recovery mechanism implemented for non-secretariat clients
- Several entities including ECE and UNCTAD fully migrated to Indico.UN version 2; others in progress, e.g. OHCHR, WHO, DESA etc.
- Access authorization module for long-term accreditation deployed for MALU and **UNIS** Geneva
- ESCAP, ESCWA and ECA onboarded and using Indico.UN version 2

Indico.UN – Disaster Recovery Exercise (DRX)

- Goal of the DRX: Determine whether the *recovery objective* is achievable by following the *procedures* and strategies in place.
- Recovery objectives for Indico.UN:
 - Recovery Time Objective: 4 hours.
 - Recovery Point Objective: 10 minutes (in case of DRX it is 0 minutes).

RPO and RTO explained



- Procedure: documented in the Information System Contingency Plan (ISCP).
- Test was scheduled on 8th January involving everyone with DR responsibilities.



Indico.UN - DRX results and lessons learned

• The DRX was successful but took longer than expected (8 hours and 44 min in total).

Major issues	Corrective action	
Corruption of a file system used to share information (NAS).	New enterprise level NAS solution deployed to replace the internal NAS (Power Scale).	
Connectivity issues.	Missing connections were implemented. Connections not working were fixed.	
Connection to some internet services was not working.	Proxy configuration has been reviewed and standarized.










Integration with Zoom



- Indico.UN developers have created an integration between Indico.UN and Zoom to create a Zoom room directly in Indico.UN by authorized users
- Each organization in Indico.UN can use its own corporate Zoom account
- Access control to create Zoom rooms managed by focal points in Indico.UN
- Naming convention for Zoom participants allowing for automatic identification of event participant in the following format: Reptype-Entity represented (5 characters)-Firstname (1st letter). Lastname
 E.g: Gov-France-P.Dupont
- Contact the Indico.UN support team using <u>iNeed</u> for support or Training








Creates event entry in Indico.UN and requests creation of Zoom room

Requests Zoom room via API




Receives information about the Zoom room and adds it to the event entry







No event <u>ending after Oct 1st</u> to be created in version 1



Indico.UN budget expenditure



\$0.86M expenditure to date (April 2022) corresponding to 33% of the overall approved budget

13.15 FTEs staff, 7 consultants/contractors

0.5 FTE staff (Feb 1st) and 1 contractor (Apr 4st) onboarded
