MEMORANDUM TO: United Nations, Division of Healthcare Management  
And Occupational Safety and Health.

SUBJECT: Use of Tactical Combat Casualty Care principals, techniques and educational materials in the United Nations Field Medical Assistant Course.

1. A prehospital care course is being developed to teach United Nations (UN) soldiers the principals of tactical combat casualty care that have been developed and promulgated by the U.S. Department of Defense's Committee on Tactical Combat Casualty Care (CoTCCC).
2. The CoTCCC acknowledged that the United Nations intends to adopt Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC) principles into the United Nation's course: Field Medical Assistant Course (FMAC). The intent to use the majority of principals and techniques of TCCC has been disclosed. The entirety of the TCCC course will not be used because of some of the inherent differences in the US and UN systems of care. A copy of the finalized FMAC resources will be provided to the Chair of the CoTCCC for reference. This acknowledgment will be subject to a periodic review by the Joint Trauma System.
3. The FMAC material is referenced to TCCC and the change of content is clearly defined so as to distinguish between UN and TCCC terms. The change of name and the use of Tactical Field Medical Aid identifies this as a clearly separate entity from TCCC and so does not breach Copyright. Unchanged materials may be utilized from the Deployed Medicine resources.
