



## **HYPOTHERMIA TREATMENT**

- **MINIMIZE** the casualty's exposure to the elements.
- **O2 ENSURE** bleeding is controlled and assess for hemorrhagic shock.
- OPEN the active heating device and/or passive warming materials and remove the device or blanket.

- **EXPOSE** any active heating device to air (per manufacturers' guidance).
- REMOVE any wet clothing, replacing with dry clothes/ other dry materials, if possible.
- of If applicable, REMOVE and OPEN warming shell completely, place casualty centered on it.



- APPLY the active heating device to the casualty.

  CAUTION: Do not place active heating device directly on the skin.
- If active heating device not available, **PLACE** passive warming materials (blanket, etc.) around casualty.
- WRAP entire passive warming materials completely around the casualty, incl. the head.

  NOTE: Do not cover up the casualty's face.

- **SECURE** the shell/blanket with tape.
- **MONITOR** the casualty closely for life-threatening conditions.
- **DOCUMENT** all findings and treatments on a DD Form 1380 TCCC Casualty Card.
