Background

The Annual Geneva Interfaith Dialogue convenes a diverse panel of Ambassadors and other high-level representatives of the world's major faiths, as well as the International Geneva community at large, to engage on the links between faith, politics, and society. The Dialogue is held on the premises of the United Nations Office at Geneva (UNOG) each year during the World Interfaith Harmony Week. It serves as a platform not simply to commemorate UNGA Resolution 65/5, but as a vehicle to raise public awareness, to renew the Resolution's commitments, and to build capacity for putting the Resolution's values into practice across the world.

Format

This year, the event will be held in a hybrid format, taking place in Room XXII of the Palais des Nations. Speakers and audience members alike will join in-person, with a public broadcast provided via Webex. Those who wish to attend in person but do not have a UN badge may gain an event pass by registering on Indigo (link below)

Content

This year's sessions consists of two panel discussions: Faith and Multilateralism", and "Faith and Public Policy". Each session will have five speakers, in which each speaker shall relay their own opinion on their respective topic. Following this, each speaker shall explain in what ways their government or organization leverages either the synergies between faith and multilateralism or faith and public policy, depending on their respective topic. We kindly ask the speakers to respect the time limit of ten minutes allotted to them.
