1. Adoption of the agenda

The ninety-fifth session will be held from 15 January to 2 February 2024. The first meeting of the session will be convened on Monday, 15 January, at 10 a.m. Geneva time at Palais Wilson.

Under the present item, the Committee will consider its programme of work for the session, as well as any other matters concerning the performance of its functions under the Convention.

The Committee will have before it a working paper on options and guiding questions for the development of an implementation plan for the conclusions adopted by the Chairs of the treaty bodies at the thirty-fourth annual meeting and confirmed at the thirty-fifth meeting of the Chairs.
