## Gender Transformative Approach (GTA) as an instrument to operationalize the Right to Development (RtD)

"Best practices for the Right to Development, jointly led by developed and developing nations"

The right to development faces constant challenges in being instrumentalized due to a lack of understanding of what development would be like through the RtD Approach. This scarcity of understanding of RtD in practice is unfortunate. To address these obstacles, it is important to identify already existing best practices in development policy and cooperation that work according to the principles of the RtD.

Gender Transformative Approaches (GTAs) can be identified as one such practice in development cooperation, which is widely welcomed by all actors in the development cooperation cycle, including donors, people, implementing agencies, and local authorities. GTAs are development approaches that put the beneficiaries (women) in the center of a self-led development process, enabling their leadership and ensuring a fair share of benefit therefrom. GTAs address the root causes of gender inequality and empower people to remove such obstacles to lead their own development process. This is a living practice of the RtD principles and can be identified as an instrument used to protect and promote the RtD. This event shall deliberate how and where GTAs provide an opportunity to strengthen the RtD agenda, especially through a gender lens in development cooperation.

- Bring stakeholders such as members states (Developed and developing), development agencies and practitioners together to put people at the centre of the development process through a gender lens
