Guidance and support to individuals impacted by abusive conduct are available any time throughout the resolution process and may vary depending on your legal relationship with WHO.

# IF YOU ARE IMPACTED BY ABUSIVE CONDUCT, WHO CAN YOU CONTACT FOR GUIDANCE AND SUPPORT?

#### - Office of Compliance, Risk Management and Ethics for

- Information and advice on resolution mechanisms available and protection against retaliation
- Referral to internal and external local services specializing in abusive conduct, sexual harassment, violence against women and violence against LGBTIQ+ individuals

- Confidentially making a report of abusive conduct through the Integrity Hotline

#### - First or second level manager/supervisor for

- Information on where to obtain confidential advice, assistance, and options available

- Support to address alleged incidents

#### - Human Resources for

- Information on reporting options and possible interim measures

- Support and guidance on how to report to, and what to expect from, local authorities

#### - The Ombudsman for

- Confidential discussion and information on the options available to address possible abusive conduct

- Mediation/facilitated discussion

#### - Security Officer for

- Immediate assistance for safety and physical security

- Documentation of an incident concerning safety and physical security

### - Staff Associations for

- Information and advice on reporting options and support and guidance during the process

## - Staff Counsellor/Staff Psychologist for

- Psycho-social counselling and recommendations for referral for in-house or external psycho-social counselling

Staff Health and Wellbeing Services for
- Medical support

If the abusive conduct involves physical violence, you should contact the emergency security services in the duty station and/or police, and seek urgent medical attention.
