9. Weather and temperature

Average temperatures rise for additional few degrees Celsius (several degrees Fahrenheit) in the Swiss city of Geneva in May. In general, daily temperatures range from 8C(46.4F) to 18C(64.4F) this time of year.

10. Electricity

The voltage in Switzerland, as in most of Europe, is 230V/50 Hz. Switzerland uses type C (2-pin) and Type J (3-pin) plugs. (Type C 2-pin plugs also fit J sockets.). Most power sockets are designed for three pin round plugs. The standard continental type plug with two round pins, applied for many electrical travel products, may be used without problem.



11. Currency

The official currency is the **Swiss franc**. All major department stores, many shops, businesses, hotels, restaurants and souvenir shops accept Euros as payment. However, your change will be given in Swiss francs.

12. Dialling code

If you need to call Switzerland, the international country code is +41.

If calling from Switzerland, you need to enter the international country code of the destination.

13. Language

English is the official language of the meeting.

In Geneva, French and English are spoken in most of public places, shops and restaurants.
