

3. Revision of the Protocol to Abate Acidification, Eutrophication and Ground-level Ozone, as amended in 2012

Tentative timing: Monday, 26 May, morning and afternoon, Tuesday, 27 May, morning and afternoon

4. With decision 2023/5 (ECE/EB.AIR/154), adopted at its forty-third session (Geneva, 11–14 December 2023), the Executive Body initiated the process of revising the Protocol to

Abate Acidification, Eutrophication and Ground-level Ozone (the Gothenburg Protocol), as amended in 2012, in order to address the conclusions of the report on the review of the Protocol (ECE/EB.AIR/150/Add.2). At its forty-fourth session (Geneva, 9-12 December 2024), with its decision 2024/2, the Executive Body adopted the plan for the revision of the Gothenburg Protocol, as amended in 2012 (ECE/EB.AIR/156/Add.2). In accordance with the plan (para. 15 (a) and table 2), the Working Group is invited to discuss new emission reduction commitments for pollutants currently covered by the Protocol, as well as potential revisions to technical annexes, including those related to their scope and level of ambition. The Working Group is also invited to discuss the feasibility and utility of options for including methane in the revised Protocol, as well as new flexibilities and other approaches for non-Parties, taking into account relevant discussions by the Executive Body at its fortyfourth session (ECE/EB.AIR/156, forthcoming). As a part of its deliberations, the Working Group may wish to take into account the effects-based scenarios at different levels of ambition for cost-effective strategies to reduce emissions to be provided by the Task Force on Integrated Assessment Modelling. In accordance with the request of the Executive Body, the Working Group should also take into account any work progressed by the Task Force on Techno-economic Issues in its discussions on the nature, status and content of the technical annexes. The Working Group may also wish to further discuss the merits of the Batumi Action for Cleaner Air approach for non-Parties.
