

CONSULTATION ON MENTAL HEALTH AND HUMAN RIGHTS

23 October 2024

Room XVII, Palais des Nations, Geneva

1. Registration

Participants are required to register online on the <u>Indico platform</u> (<u>https://indico.un.org/event/1013762/</u>) before COB (Geneva time) on Monday, 21 October 2024, as afterwards the portal will be closed.

In order to complete the formalities and receive the identification badge, participants are requested to proceed to Pregny Gate of Palais des Nations, 14, Avenue de la Paix, 1202 Geneva. All participants will be issued an identification badge which will allow access to the premises of Palais des Nations and conference venues. For security reasons, the badge must be visible at all times.

To receiver your badge to the meeting venue, participants need to bring the QR-code in the email confirmation, which you should have received upon registration, along with a valid identification document (passport) to Pregny Gate. The UN Security Registration office is open from Monday to Friday, 8.00 - 17.00 (non-stop). We encourage you to pick up your identification badge a day before the meeting, if possible, or before 9:00 on the first day.

2. Access to the Palais des Nations

By public transportation: You can access Palais des Nations by bus or tram. The Appia stop (near bus lines 8, 20, 22, 60 and 61) is nearest to the Pregny Gate. Alternatively, the Place des Nations (Nations) stop (by bus lines 5, 8, 11, 20 and 22 and tram line 15) is the nearest to the Peace Gate. Lines 8, 20, 60, 61, 5, and 15 connects the Cornavin Station to the Palais des Nations (approx. 15-20 min). Bus line 5 connects the Palais des Nations (the Peace Gate) and the Geneva Cointrin Airport (approx. 15-20 min). By taxi: Taxis can take you only to the entrance at the Pregny Gate. Access to the inside of the Palais des Nations by taxi is prohibited at all times. From the airport to the Palais des Nations by taxi takes approx.15 min and costs about CHF40.

By car: Only vehicles with stickers issued by UNOG Security and Safety Section can access Palais des Nations.

Luggage: It is not authorized to enter Palais des Nations with large luggage (i.e. bigger than carry-on size). Participants carrying large luggage are kindly asked to make other arrangements.


3. Access to Room XVII

Conference room XVII is located on the first floor of the E-building, entering door 40. See the attached document for further details.

4. Connecting your electronic devices at Palais des Nations

Please mind that Switzerland has its own standard plug. Do not forget to bring an adapter to load the battery of your electric devices. Unfortunately, the UN cannot lend plugs, chargers, and adapters.

For Switzerland there are two associated plug types, types C and J. Plug type C is the plug which has two round pins and plug type J is the plug which has three round pins. Switzerland operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz. If needed, you can purchase international adapters at shops at the Geneva Airport. At the Cornavin Station, at K Kiosk, you can find adapters to convert Type A (used in mainly USA) to Type C or J, or to convert USB type C cable to plug type C or J.



At the Palais des Nations, the "UNOG_Public_Wifi" network is open to all conference participants and does not require a password. Access to it is available in common areas and the meeting rooms.

5. Restaurants, cafeteria and bars

8. Accommodation

Participants are expected to arrange their accommodation during their stay in Geneva by themselves. The United Nations does not make hotel reservations for participants. Hotels around the Cornavin Station, the central station of Geneva, may give you easier access to the Palais des Nations as well as the rest of the city by public transportation. 11. Local currency

In Geneva, as in the rest of Switzerland, the currency used is the Swiss Franc (CHF). While some businesses, especially those catering to tourists, might accept Euros, it's not a widespread practice, and the exchange rate may not be favourable.

Bank and credit cards are widely accepted in hotels, restaurants, and shops. However, it may be a good idea to have some Swiss Francs on hand for smaller purchases, public transport tickets, and for those places that don't accept cards.
