# Economic development in Africa: Unlocking Africa's trade potential – Boosting regional markets and reducing risks

3. Under the agenda item, the Board will consider the *Economic Development in Africa Report 2024*: *Unlocking Africa's Trade Potential – Boosting Regional Markets and Reducing Risks.* The nexus between trade, regional integration and stability is analysed in the report, with a view to advancing effective mechanisms to strengthen Africa's resilience in the face of interconnected global challenges. A road map is provided for proactive and adaptative strategies and programmes through which trade enterprises, economic agents and investors (domestic and foreign) can use trade (particularly intra-African trade) and regional cooperation (enhancing trade and economic partnerships) to mitigate perceived exposure to shocks and address immediate vulnerabilities to the polycrisis.
