the main road for a few minutes until you see GIZ campus on your left-hand side.

• From Bonn main station, you can also take the trains RB48 (in the direction of Bonn-Mehlem) or RE5 (in the direction of Koblenz), get off at **Bonn UN Campus** and walk to the GIZ venue within 5 minutes.

The main entrance to GIZ building (marked with a red cross on the picture below) is right at the corner of the street, opposite the giant brown-metal installation (see pictures below). The exact address for GIZ office is <u>Friedrich-Ebert-Allee 32</u> in case you use Google Maps to help you with navigating.

#### Collect your GIZ visitor badge

To enter the GIZ building, you will need to collect a visitor badge from 8:30 to 9:50 am in the registration desk at GIZ. Please bring your personal identification document.
