

INFORMATION NOTE

Reaching the World Health Organization, Geneva, Switzerland

The World Health Organization (WHO/OMS) headquarters is situated on the outskirts of Geneva at the end of Avenue Appia, approximately three kilometres from the centre of town, and about one and a half kilometres from the Palais des Nations (UN). http://www.whygeneva.ch/.

Badges upon arrival:

Upon arrival at the main WHO building, you must **check in at the security desk**. A passport will need to be shown when you arrive to receive your badge. In case several events take place on the same day, queues might occur, you are therefore asked to **arrive 30- 45 minutes prior to the meeting on the first day only.** Once you arrive at the front desk, give your name and state that you are attending the "WHO-UTC Action Framework Meeting" to receive your badge. Once you receive your badge, you will be directed to the D building, also called UNAIDS BUILDING. The meeting room **D46025** is on the 4th Floor. Signs will be posted to guide you. If you have any issues upon arrival, please contact Chantal Berthoud

Free transport card

The Geneva International Airport offers a free

ticket giving access to public transport in Geneva for a period of 80 minutes. This «Unireso» ticket can be picked up from the machine in the baggage collection area at the Arrival level. The only requirement is possession of proof of incoming air travel (e.g. boarding pass, airline ticket).



Most of the hotels in the city offer a free public transport ticket for the duration of your stay. You will receive it during the check-in. This card can be used any time and it is accepted in all kind of transport within Geneva canton (bus, tram, boat).

Where to buy tickets/card

In case you don't receive a free public transportation card, individual tickets are also available from vending machines at the bus stops. Please note that some vending machines do not give change. Cards for multiple trips at a reduced price can be purchased at the Naville Kiosk from newsstands in town bearing the «TPG» sign.

By Taxi

It takes about ten minutes to get to WHO from the airport (CHF 25-30) or from the main railway station (CHF 20 – 25). A taxifare to the centre of town amounts to CHF 35-50, depending on the route and location. The receptionist at the WHO main reception desk can request taxis or a taxi can be called by telephone by dialling the following numbers: 022 320 20 20, 022 320 22 02 and 022 33 141 33.

Geneva - some practical information

Local currency is Swiss Francs (CHF). Euro (EUR) is the currency in France and is also accepted at restaurants and shops in Switzerland. It is advisable to change money into local currency. Besides many "Bureaux de Changes", which are often located close to railway-stations, airports and hotels, banks can be found all over the city. Outside the opening-hours, many cash machines are available to serve you.
