The Problem

- Long queues by conference participants at the Pregny Gate (Palais des Nations, UNOG)
- Overhead for Security Service
- Inadequate IT systems to handle participant volume
- Unsatisfactory service to participants
- Multiple registration methods (spreadsheets, contact databases, emails, etc)
- Poor UN image



The Project

- Mandated by the UNOG DG
- Supported by UNOG/SSS
- Conceived in 2015
 - improve IT systems
 - modernise processes
- Implemented by
UNOG/DCM/ITS and UNOG/DOA/ICTS



Expected Benefits

- ❖ Shorter and faster queues at the Pregny Gate
- ❖ Increased efficiency by Security
- ❖ Expanded services to conference participants
- ❖ Modernised business processes
- ❖ Improved UN image
- ❖ Support for remote venues
- ❖ Analytics & Statistics
- ❖ Harmonisation and rationalisation of IT systems

The Solution

Indico (Integrated Digital Conference)

- Developed and used by CERN since 2004
- Free and Open Source
- Used by 40+ institutions & organizations globally
- Customisable and scalable

Some features...

Out of the box

- ▷ Online registration and approval
- ▷ Information sharing and collaboration (documents, recordings, web pages, etc)
- ▷ Resource booking (rooms, services) and meeting planning
- ▷ Paper reviewing and abstracts management
- ▷ Badge design
- ▷ Surveys
- ▷ Payment gateway

Customisation and improvements by UNOG

- ▷ Adaptation to UN workflows and automation of procedures (invitations, notifications, approval, etc)
- ▷ Security automation: QR-code scanning, passport & ID scanning, check-in, badge printing, blacklisting, calendar views
- ▷ On-behalf registrations, bulk registrations
- ▷ Integration with conference management systems (iCSO, eMeets, gDoc, ODS)
- ▷ Statistics

The Pilot and Phase 2

- Pilot with UNCTAD XIV in Nairobi in July 2016
 - ~7000 participants registered
 - ~6600 badges issued
- Full implementation at UNOG
 - from Sep. 2016 to Dec. 2017
- Information Security strengthening
 - Audit by independent external company
- Infrastructure improvements
 - UNOG data center

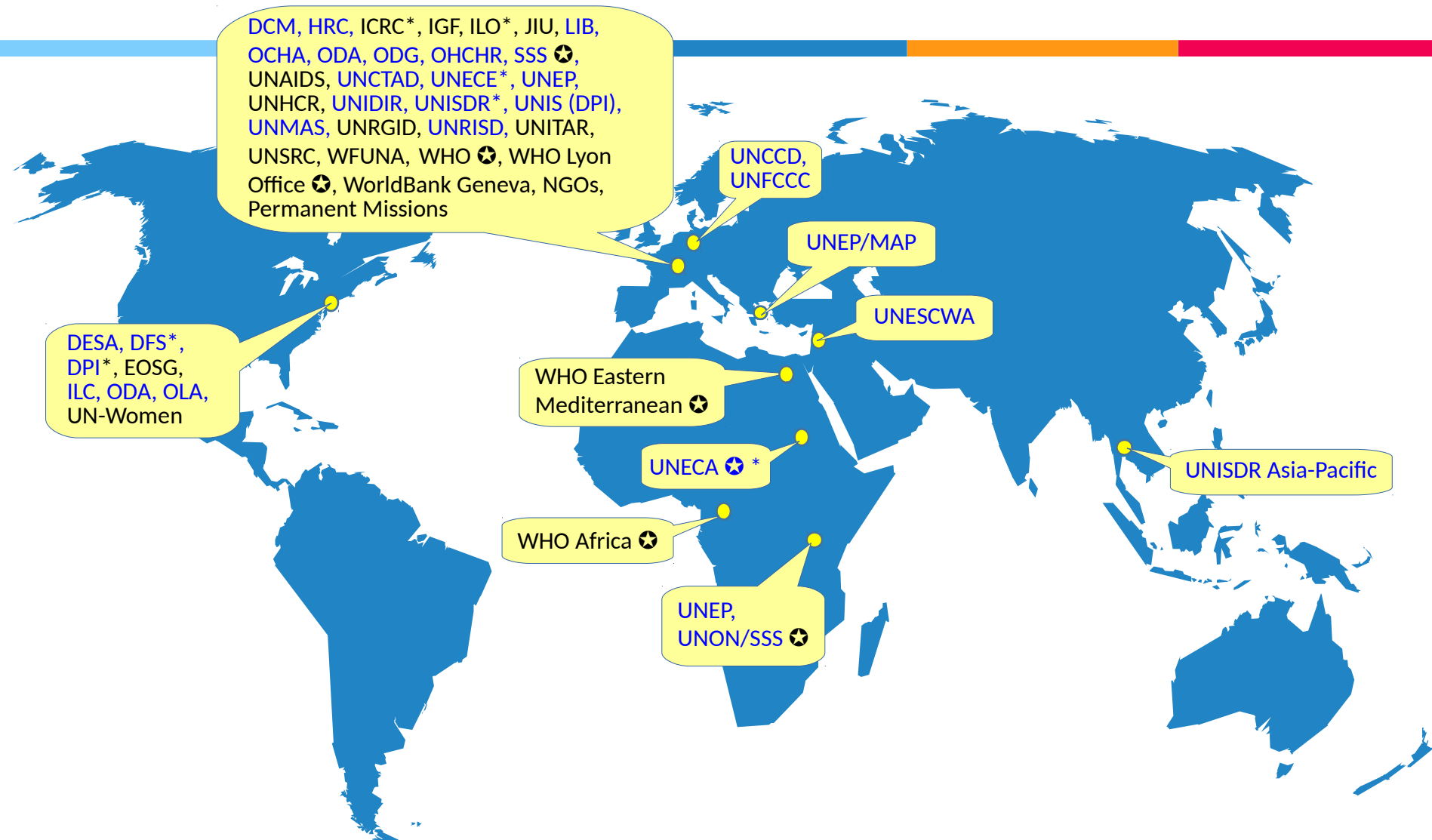

- Adopted by **umojja** for Meeting Participants Management (Umoja Extension 2), to be deployed for all UN Secretariat entities in 2019
- Standardisation by OICT/ARB in 2018 [done]
- Migration to Enterprise Data Centers in 2018 [in progress]
- Pilots with entities in Umoja Extension 2 scope in 2018 [done]
- Upgrade to v2 from CERN in 2019 [in progress]
- Feature extension

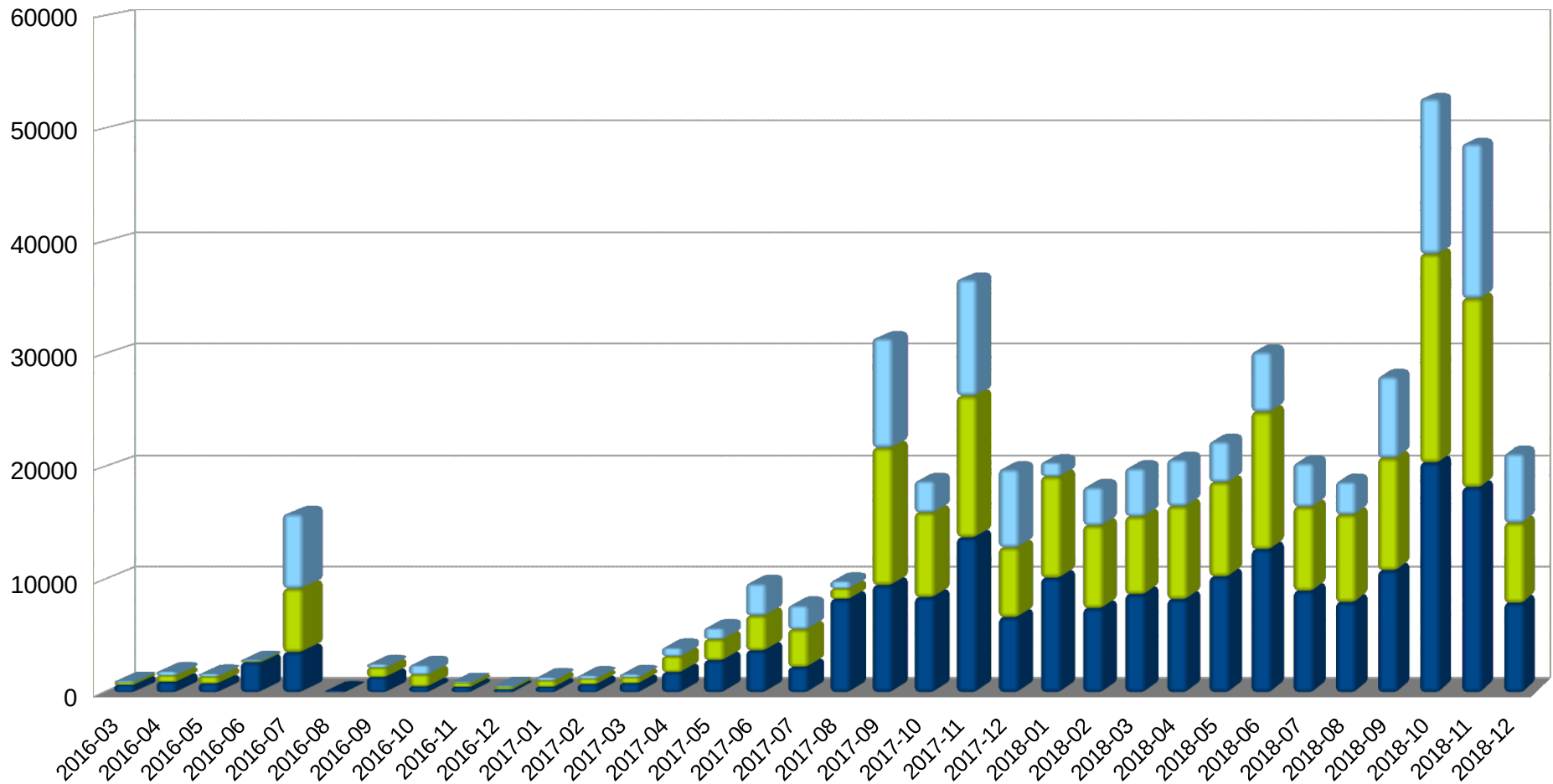

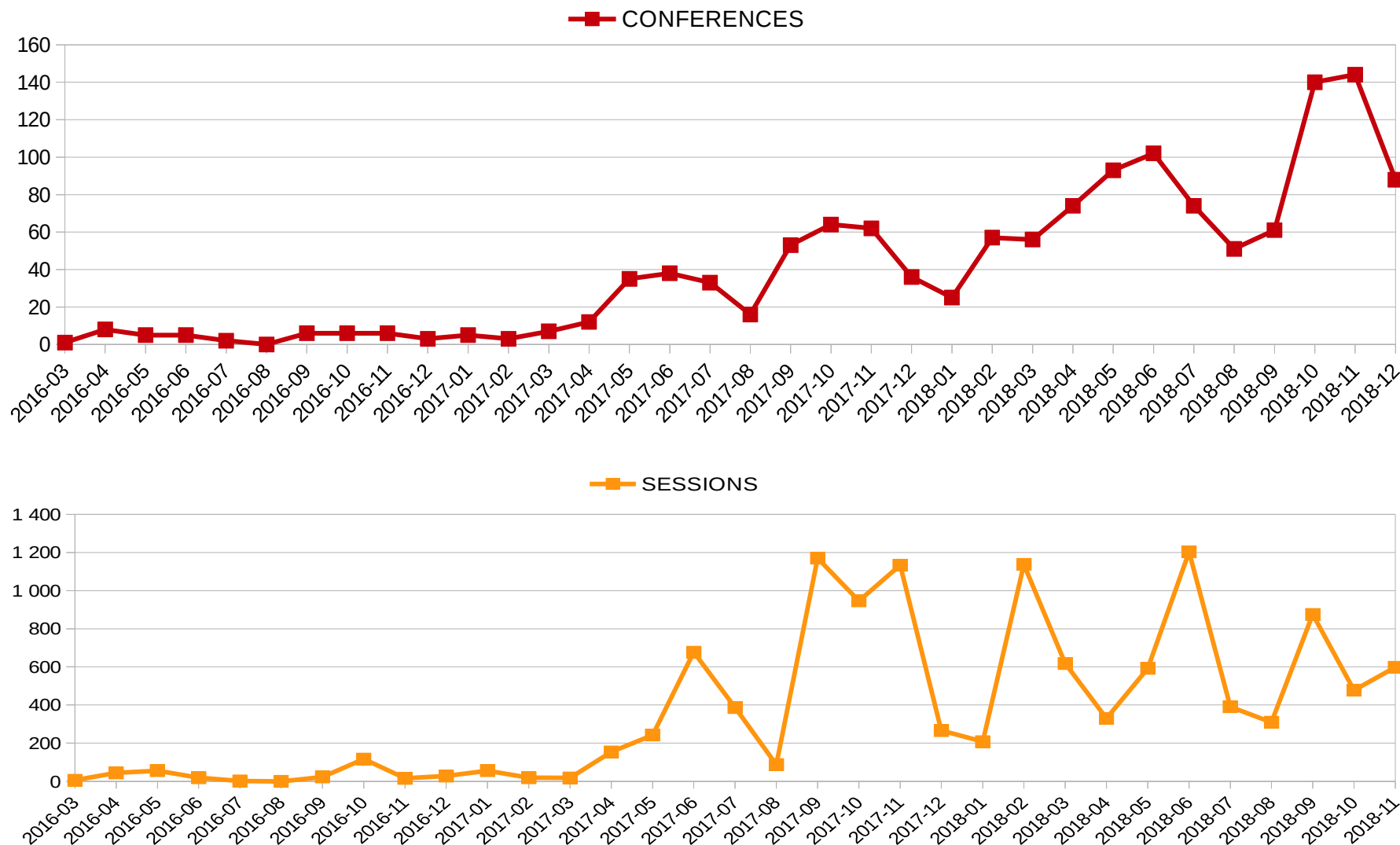

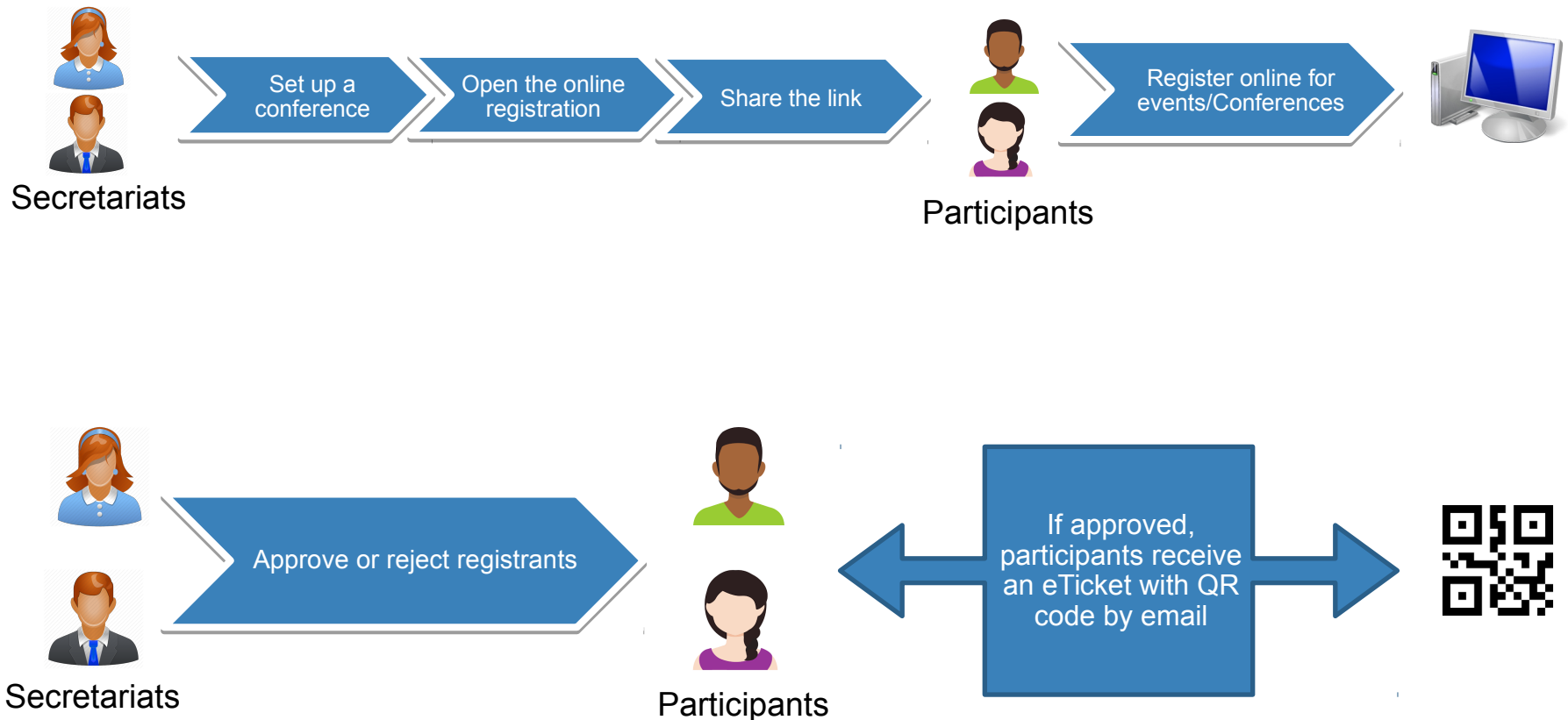

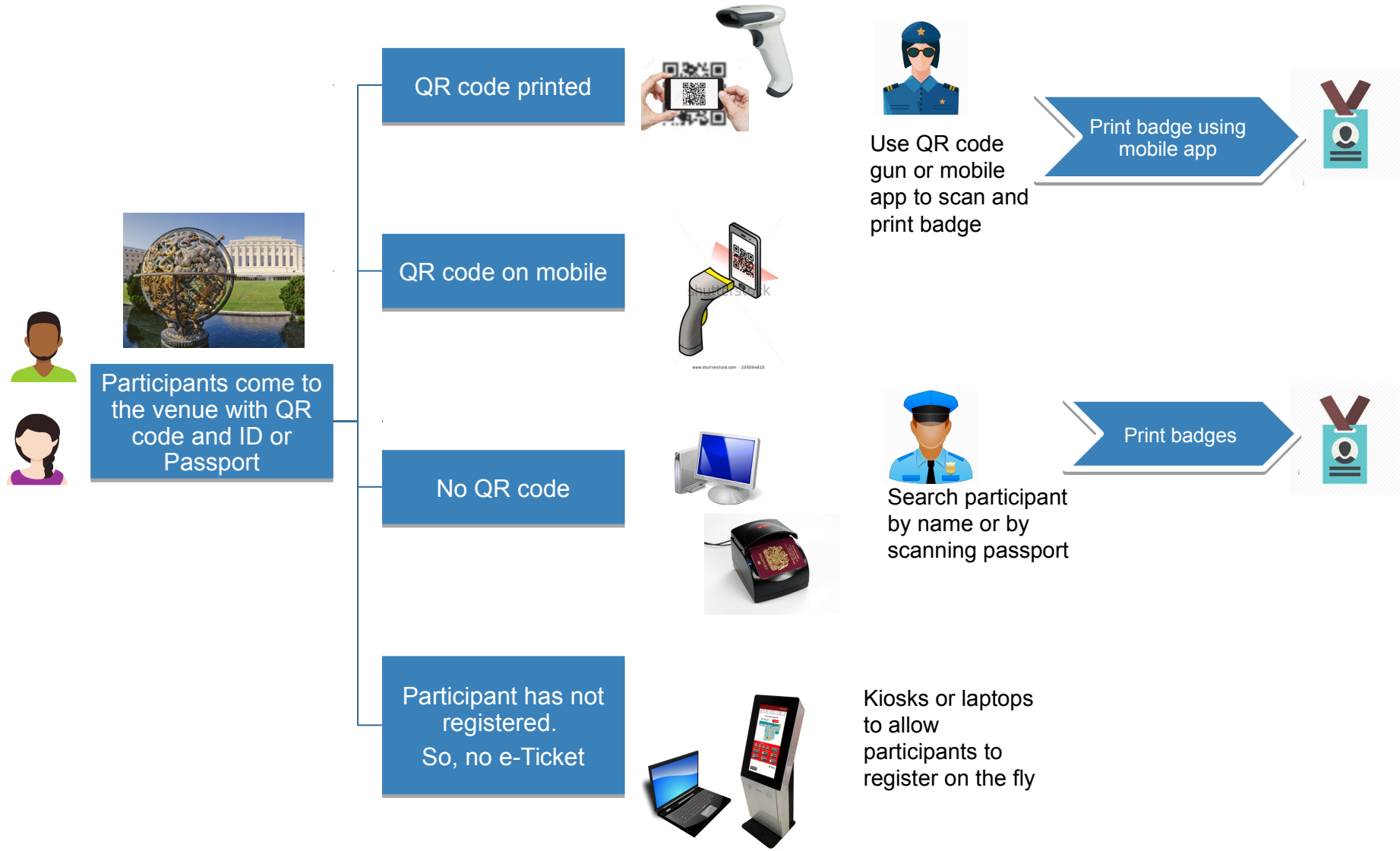

Basic Indico Workflow 2/2



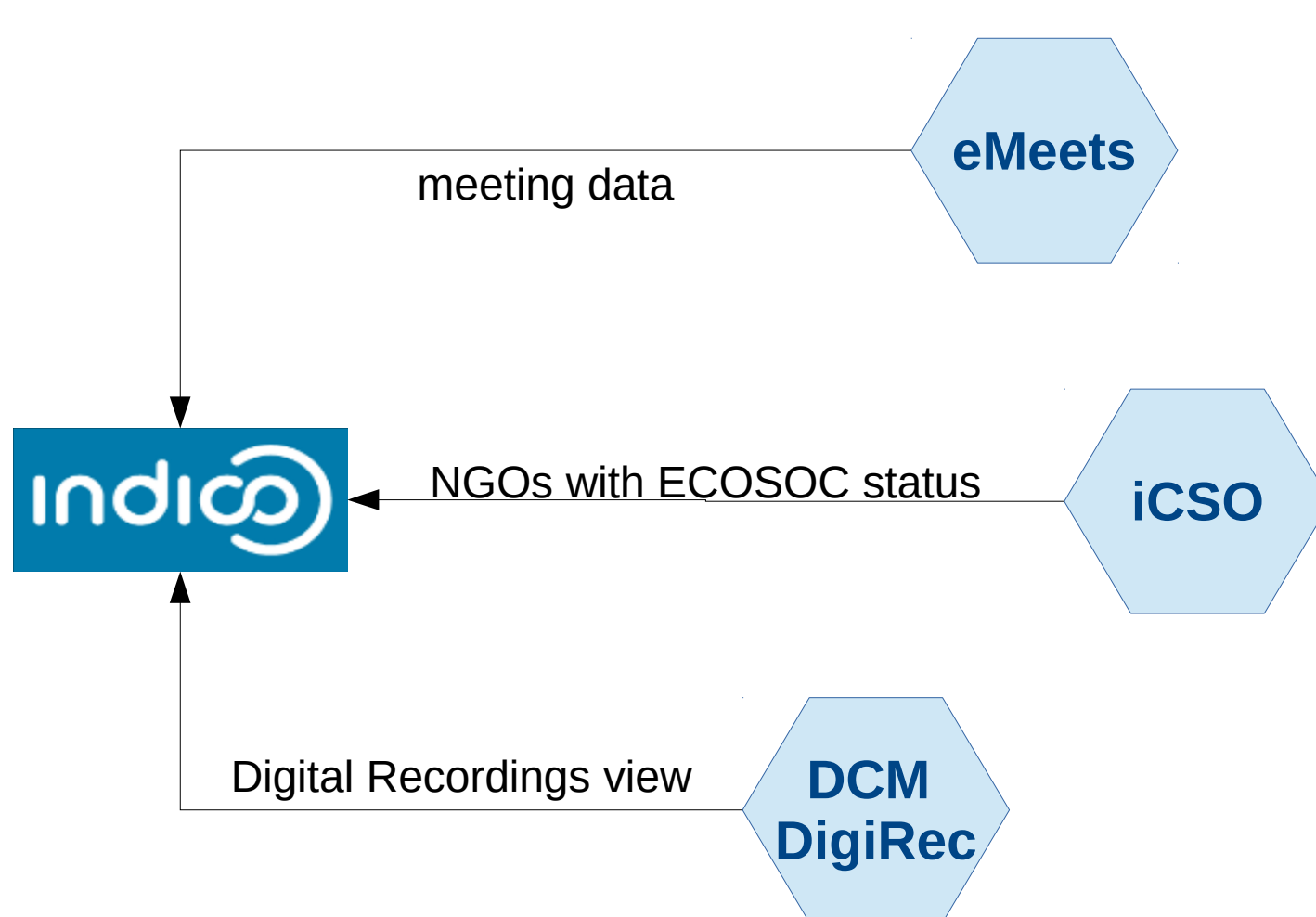
